General Qualifications Required:

 - c. Be adaptive to a variety of situations.
4. A love for the Lord and a desire to see children come to know Christ as Savior.
5. Recommendation from your pastor or DOM.
6. A Criminal Background check completed.

Duties of the Cabin Leader:

1. The Cabin Leader is responsible for being with the children from the start of camp to the close of camp. You will be the one who has the best opportunity to show them God's love and lead them down the road of salvation.
2. The Cabin Leader is responsible for getting the children to activities on time. Make sure everyone is participating, including you. Keep things positive and fun while maintaining discipline and order.
3. The Cabin Leader is responsible for assisting and overseeing your group of children when they are assigned duties such as cleaning the restrooms and cleaning up the kitchen after meals.
4. The Cabin Leader is responsible for seeing that the cabins are kept neat and in order each day.
5. The Cabin Leader is responsible to see that the cabin is clean and neat before leaving at the end of the camp week. This means trash thrown out, items picked up, cabin swept out, etc.
6. The Cabin Leader is responsible to see that the camp is kept clean by having your children assist in picking up trash and cleaning the camp.
7. The Cabin Leader is responsible for seeing that there are at least two adults with your children at all times.
8. The Cabin Leader is responsible for working cooperatively together with the other Cabin leaders, camp staff and the Camp Director.
9. The Cabin Leader is responsible to get to know your children, there background, likes and dislikes so that you can hopefully have opportunities to minister and witness to them throughout the week.
10. The Cabin Leader is responsible for daily cabin devotions in the cabin.

- 4. The Junior Leader is responsible to help see that the cabins are kept neat and in order each day.
- 5. The Junior Leader is responsible to help see that the cabin is clean and neat before leaving at the end of the camp week. This means trash thrown out, items picked up, cabin swept out, etc.
- 6. The Junior Leader is responsible to help see that the camp is kept clean and neat by having your children assist in picking up trash and cleaning the camp.
- 7. The Junior Leader is responsible for working cooperatively together with Cabin leaders, camp staff and the Camp Director.
